Meeting of July 11, 2022

The meeting came to order by Brady Anderson at 7pm

Treasurer's Report for June 2022

At this time we are still awaiting all of the prior cabinet information so we do not have a treasury report.

Old Business

- 1) None at this time

New Business:

- 1) Announced Daryl as the property chairman. Daryl was supposed to be on his 2nd term as a board member, but due to an error in the ballots the board voted him in as the property chairman which as in the original constitution is a voting member
 - a) Daryl discussed that there are many things we want to do to update the range. Some of the main items are getting the forest service sign back up. Cleaning up the trash around the range. Picking up and replacing broken concrete yardage markers. The seats on the course at the shooting position that don't have wood or are not in good shape need to be replaced.
 - b) Tom was a painter so he advised he might be able to help get some paint at either a discounted rate or as a donation.
 - c) We would also like to have the main road graded. Questions were presented if we know anyone who could do that or give us a quote. Suggestions were given as to Rick Livingston or James Bruner
- 2) We will be having a range clean up date July 30th focusing on trash pick up and the markers. (You can register via the facebook event)
- 3) Autumn agreed to work with Daryl regarding options to allow the boy scouts help for service hours.
- 4) Sin City Rack Pack has their 3rd shoot of their series this weekend, July 16th. PreRegistration end Monday at 9pm. There will be 20 shooting stations with 25 total targets (5 double targets). Most shots will be over the canyons or thru trees. Range finders are encouraged as shooting will not occur at normal shooting positions.
- 5) July 23rd SCA will be holding an event all members are welcomed to come. They are a group that holds Old School Renaissance events with primitive weapons.
- 6) A change to the Bi-Laws and Constitution has been sent out will be voted for change at the August meeting.
- 7) Some of the changes we are going to have are committees to help around the club.
 - a) One of those is the Target Committee we previously had someone assigned to every target and it was their responsibility to check on it once a month and to pick up any trash around and to help with upkeep on the target. If anything is needed please let Darryl know.
 - b) The Jr Board Member position is a non voting position we are looking to see if something the club would like. It is for member 12 - 17 years old. and a way to help bring our youth to be more involved and to see how the club runs
- 8) The club has an AED machine that we are getting a wall box for, the pads are currently expired so we are replacing those as well. Since we have the AED machine we would like to offer a First Aid/CPR/AED class which you will receive your certificate after. It is \$35 and we need 10-15 members to schedule (you can sign up using the survey sent out)
- 9) Sin City Rack Pack presented the option to hold their shoots at LVA next year. They would like to do their trio of shoots in Feb, April and May or April, May, June. They also requested to hold their night shoot October 2023.
 - a) Tara motioned to move SCRIP to hold shoots next year
 - b) Melissa second motion
 - c) Everyone agreed to have SCRIP hold their shoots with LVA next year

- d) Frank did mention it would be nice for LVA to schedule their shoots before SCRP, we agreed that with both shops having S3D clubs we should check out other local shoots and try not to schedule the same weekend as other major shoots
- 10) Brady Anderson advised that the Safari shoot will be taking place Sept 24th & 25th. They do not have a flier. Autumn agreed to create the flier.
 - a) Urgent motion placed by Melissa to have Autumn create Safari Shoot flier
 - b) Tara seconded the motion
 - c) Everyone agreed no one opposed
- 11) Charlie advised that he is working on getting our non profit status back and will need Frank's help with the survey.
- 12) We still need a 3d unmarked and marked championship shoot.
 - a) Anna agreed to change from doing the Halloween shoot a 3d unmarked championship shoot in October
 - b) Chuy agreed to change one of his 3d Shoots to the marked outdoor shoot.
- 13) Thanksgiving shoot will be Nov 12th at 9am. Pricing will be \$30/\$40
- 14) We do need a new grill as the ones we have currently are broken. Daryl is working with Cal Ranch to see if they will donate one possibly a flat top instead of the traditional BBQ.
- 15) There has possibly been someone not authorized on the range. We have seen an uptake of trash around the barn. If you see someone who shouldn't be there and do not want to approach them please take a picture and send it to the gmail we will deal with it.
- 16) Chuy has been working on updating the 3d course. We are thinking about moving some of the old targets to the broad head pit giving you an option of shooting those since they are pretty much blown out and cant be replaced.
 - a) We did have a member who advised they would be open to holding a clinic on how to replace and fix 3d targets (you can sign up for this via the survey)
- 17) Chuy advised that the Nevada Department of Wildlife will put on a bow hunting education seminar at LVA. This would be free (sign up on the survey)
