Treasurer's report was reviewed by Brandi B (please see end of minutes for full report), notation that there is a cash deposit listed on 10/14/2024 which will be deposited on 10/15/2024 due to a bank holiday.

Old Business

- Absolutely no broadheads are to be shot into the targets at the range. This shouldn't continue to be an issue as we are nearing the end of archery hunting season. Please remember that broadheads are only allowed in the broadhead pit.
- The QR code has been updated to include the liability waivers, so if you are bringing a guest and they would like to pay their Range Donation using the QR code they can sign the liability waiver at the same time electronically. Waivers have also been added to the sign in box at the bottom of the clubhouse stairs, once it has been signed please move it to the back.
- The SCA event was held and was successful.
- Issuing member cards was discussed by the board and the board has advised that this is not cost prohibitive at this time to move forward with.
- Gate must be shut and locked as you enter and exit to prevent guests from being locked in. Please make sure you are actually locking the gate lock and not dummy locking it.
- After board discussion we will not be limiting the number of times someone is able to visit the range as a guest before they are asked to become a member. Please remember guests are asked for a \$10 donation EACH time they come visit the range.
- Forest Services will be in touch to set up the dates and times to start the NEPO analysis. This is needed as part of the process to obtain our land lease for the next 20 years. The range will have to be closed during the analysis as they are hoping for all departments to be able to meet at the same time.
- Work party on 9/21 was successful, thank you Randall Belmonte, Melissa Bendig, Jason Miller, Eric York, Mike Sowers, Bill & Denise Edwards, Ean & Ethan Porlas and Brandi Bush.

- Since our last meeting we have had our Stan Magee Championship, Unmarked Championship and Marked Championship shoots. They were all successful with great turnouts thank you to everyone who came out to shoot.
- Sin City Rack Pack hosted their Halloween night Shoot thank you to them.
- We have had a total of 25 new memberships since July 2024.

New Business

- We have seen guests signing in, but stating that they are members and not paying the daily \$10 guest donation. This is the formal warning for all members that this is not acceptable. This will be a topic of discussion at the next board meeting on how to move forward if this continues.
- Tom Campbell asked to place a motion to the club present that Kent Kizerian resign effective immediately as President of Las Vegas Arches due to the mishandling of Alejandro's termination from the board and the mistreatment of club members. Brady asked for a discussion, at this time Autumn advised that she would make the decision and Kent and Autumn walked out of the meeting.
- Brady offered as the past president to assist as an interim president to continue the meeting until a new president could be nominated and voted in as per club constitution.
- We are looking for hosts for the Thanksgiving and Christmas shoot if anyone is interested please let the board know. Discussion was had about possibly combining both the Thanksgiving and Christmas shoot to a single day, making it a holiday shoot instead. Without members stepping up to volunteer as host for these shoots the club will be unable to support both shoots separately. Currently the Thanksgiving shoot is on the calendar for Saturday, November 9th. Donald P advised he can tentatively host, however, he will need to coordinate and review his work schedule as he is out of state working right now.
- Daniel discussed that he found a company in Australia that makes some awesome Safari targets and they print them on a light banner material. The targets were purchased for this year's shoot. He has made scoring dots that fall in line with NFAA sizing per distance. We will have about 20 to 22 3D targets this year and the rest will be flat targets.
- Pre Registration for Safari shoot is open until Sunday, October 20th at 11pm PST. You can save \$10 by pre registering. Preregistration is \$40 for members and an additional \$10 for non members. Day of registration is \$50 for members and an additional \$10 for non members. Mulligans are available for 2 for \$5 and we will be having a raffle which you can purchase your raffle tickets through the pre registration form as well or day of.
- We are having a glue up work party this Saturday, October 18th at 8am at the range to glue up the Safari targets and we hope to see everyone there.
- Daniel is also looking for anyone who can help set up targets the Friday before the shoot (Friday, October 25th) and help bring targets back in after the completion of the tournament (Sunday, October 27th), if you are able to help with either please let the board know.
- We had 3 open board positions: Vice President, Secretary and Youth Board member. The Youth Board Member is a non voting position, but is great on college applications and a great way to learn how organizations run. If you know anyone who is interested in the Youth Board Member position please have them reach out.
- Jason Miller was nominated for VP, Melissa B presented a motion to accept and Tom C seconded the motion. The board would like to welcome Jason Miller as our new Vice President.

- Melissa Bendig was nominated for Secretary, John B presented a motion to accept and Shannon A seconded the motion. The board would like to welcome Melissa Bendig as our new Secretary.
- Nominations for President are now open and will remain open thru our next member meeting at which point we will vote a new President to the board. Tom C nominated John Bush who accepted the nomination.
- Brady addressed the club and discussed some of the issues the board has experienced for about the last 7 years. Issues were not solely confined to the board and at times could involve a number of members. Some issues have been enough of an issue that members were advising they were considering leaving. These have led to the high turnover rate of board members. He indicated that many of the problems could have possibly been resolved with some early communication and asks all members that if they are having a problem to reach out to a board member, if they do not feel comfortable discussing the issue with the individual they are in conflict with, so that we could try to prevent problems from becoming bigger issues later. It was pointed out that the LVA range in Nevada receives a lot of praise from both within and outside the club for its ability to host a full NFAA course without having to reshoot the same targets, the landscape, and stunning views, but we as a club need to work on our image both to members and non-members.
- Comment was raised that we need to get more kids up at the range, John B states he will talk with Aces and Arrows to see how we can help get some of their JOAD kids out to tournaments. Brady advised he did a 20 yard shoot one year where all targets were 20 yards. Comment was made that some parents don't know how to adjust the sights on their kids' bows. John B suggested maybe we host a clinic at the range to help the kids with their yardage and sight adjustments. Shannon A advised that the Boy Scouts use the North Range, and will reach out to see what we can do to get them up to LVA. Brady will reach out to a contact to see if they could direct him to a BSA staff member. - Nevada Department of Wildlife is hosting an event at Clark County Shooting Range for Middle School and High School kids on November 2nd from 9:30am to 4pm. NBHA and USA Archery will both be having booth's there and Las Vegas Archers was asked if we would like to have a booth. John B will reach out to his contact at Clark County Shooting Range to make sure we are still able to have a booth. We are asking for members to come help man the booth. Kids between the ages of 14-17 years old will be coming around and talking to all the booths to get more information. Clark County Shooting Complex will have Genesis bows available for the kids to shoot as well. A sign up sheet will be going out later this week for anyone who would like to help out, we are asking for 2 people per time slot to man the booth.
- Del Sole High School reached out and is having an archery tournament November 23rd from 9am to 12pm and they are looking for a Range Master, Safety Officer and an announcer to help with their tournament. The archers will be shooting Genesis bows at 10 and 15 yards and they will have roughly 65 middle and high school participants. There will be a similar signup sheet for that event to be emailed later this week.
